The Reason for this letter is that mild contamination in the form of Polystyrene was found in your Green Bin.

Dear Occupant,

Despite recent communications and the visit of an officer from the council we have recently detected another incidence where your recycling container was contaminated with inappropriate material and was therefore not collected by our recycling collection team.

Contaminated recycling bins restrict the ability of the council to recycle your household waste, and therefore increase the cost of Council Tax for everyone.

Items which can be recycled include: Glass bottles, plastic bottles, paper, cans.

Items which cannot be recycled include: Plastic food containers, nappies, kitchen waste.

We have now recorded that your recycling container has breached these guidelines on three separate occasions over the last 6 months, and therefore we have no alternative but to escalate this issue. We therefore will not be collecting your recycling container unless we receive assurance that it will only contain items as detailed above.
